

2015-16 Year 11 Destinations Analysis



This analysis allows schools to get an indication of the destinations of their 2015-16 year 11 pupils across a range of pupil characteristics.

The data source is the Annual Activity Survey which is designed to establish young people's destinations, on 1st November, in the year they completed compulsory education.



The Activity Survey results are made available in the annual 'Moving On' publication. The survey should not be confused with the Key Stage 4 Destination Measure, which shows sustained destinations over a period of time, albeit focussing on the same cohort.
